GUTTERS & DOWNSPOUTS - make sure they are clean and functioning properly.

STORM WINDOWS - make sure they are functioning properly and the weep holes are open.

DOORS, WINDOWS, & SILLS - check for loose caulking, peeling paint and damaged wood.

TRIM, SIDING & SHUTTERS - check for peeling paint and damaged wood.

* You may also want to purchase at least one bag of salt to be ready for the first snowfall of the season.
